Canine Parvovirus, Distemper Virus, and Adenovirus-2 Vaccines. For initial puppy vaccination (< 16 weeks), one dose of vaccine containing modified live virus (MLV) CPV, CDV, and CAV-2 is recommended every 3-4 weeks from 6-8 weeks of age, with the final booster being given no sooner than 16 weeks of age.

Types of Vaccines - AAHA

For cats > 16 weeks of age, give one attenuated live vaccine or two inactivated vaccines 3 weeks apart. The assumption here is that maternal antibody is not present. High-Risk Environment (eg., shelter): For kittens < 20 weeks of age, revaccinate every 2 weeks until no earlier than 20 weeks of age.

(Dogs >16 Wk of Age) Administer 1 or 2 doses of a combination vaccine (see below): NOTE: Dogs residing in a HIGH-RISK environment and between 16 and 20 wk (4-5 mo) of age when presented for initial vaccination may benefit from administration of 2 doses of a combination vaccine 2 to 4 wk apart.
